ARTC Working Safely in Live Signal Locations is a mandatory requirement for ARTC staff, other rail staff or contractors who must access ARTC signalling network sites to conduct an inspection or to carry out work.

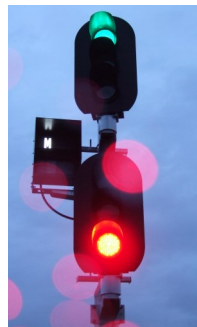
A Certificate of Completion is issued on successful completion of the training and assessment program.

ARTC-WiLL Protocols

Working safely in live signal locations (WiLL) is an essential pre-requisite for an ARTC Statement of Competency (SoC).

WiLL is also specifically required for ARTC forms F01, F04, F05, F06 and F07 (ARTC EST-20-02).

Training introduces staff and contractors to the communication protocols and duty of care requirements for working ON or NEAR the ARTC rail signalling system.

Course Content

Training and course outcomes that work for you

Course participants receive an overview of ARTC signalling systems and componentry, and communication protocols.

Critical outcomes of the WiLL course focus on maintaining the integrity of the signalling system and the importance of:

- not interfering with signalling circuits and equipment
- incident reporting
- keys and security of signalling locations
- safety when working close to live signalling circuits and equipment.

What's not covered

This training doesn't detail how the ARTC signalling system works or how technical issues are managed or resolved.

Exemptions

Irrespective of your work history or experience there are no exemptions. ARTC requires all staff and contractors to meet the SoC .
