Course content

The course addresses the competency requirements for *CPCCOHS1001A Work safely in the construction industry*.

Content includes:

- identifying OHS legislative requirements
- construction risks, hazards and control measures
- OHS communication
- Incident/emergency response procedures.

Course outcomes

On successful completion of training you'll be able to demonstrate:

- personal awareness of OHS legislative requirements, including duty of care requirements
- the basic principles of risk management and prevention of injury and illness in the construction industry
- emergency response procedure.

Your training

White card training involves a mixture of classroom theory training and practical activity.

Participants must be able to read, write and understand English.

HRD takes your training seriously and will prepare you for entry onto a construction site. The course runs over a minimum of 6 hours, but participants should allow up to 8 hours from start to finish.
