Provide CPR (HLTAID009)

Do you know what to do if someone is in cardiac arrest? What if the person is unconscious?

Provide CPR gives you the foundation skills to recognise and then manage a casualty who is unconscious and not breathing.*

Cardio-pulmonary resuscitation is a life-saving technique which can sustain life until an ambulance arrives.

Learn this valuable skill in 4 hours.

Assessment

Learners will be assessed through a quiz and demonstration of skills.

*The Australian Resuscitation Council recommends that CPR skills are recertified every 12 months.

Provide first aid (HLTAID011)

Provide first aid is the minimum requirement for workplace first aid compliance.†

Learn the skills vital to manage emergency situations and provide a first aid response, life support, casualty management and incident control until qualified emergency help arrives.

Course content

- Basic life support (DRSABCD), CPR and AED; shock management
- Airway management asthma, choking, severe allergic reaction, hyperventilation
- Cardiac emergencies; seizures and convulsions
- Bleeding and wound care; burns and scalds; poisons, bites and stings
- Musculoskeletal and abdominal injuries

Training duration

Initial training options - first time first aiders

- 2 days face-to-face OR
- 1 day mixed mode (pre-course study[‡] plus 6-8 hours practical training).

Refresher course is generally via mixed mode: pre-course study‡ plus 4-8 hours practical training.

Assessment

Assessment includes demonstration of skills, role plays, case studies, written quiz.

†The Australian Resuscitation Council recommends that first aid skills are renewed at least every 3 years.

‡Pre-course study involves reading the learner guide and undertaking a written theory test


